Medical Qigong Therapist (MQT)

This is a 500 hour Medical Qigong Therapist (MQT) certification program. This program will include oral and practical examinations plus clinical competencies. Successful completion of the examinations will enable the student to also qualify for the more advanced 1000-hour Master of Medical Qigong (MMQ) program. Prerequisite for certification in the Medical Qigong Therapist program is the successful completion of the requirements for Medical Qigong Practitioner (MQP). Graduates of any branch of the IIMQ qualify for admittance in the Georgia Branch program.

The Therapist level constitutes 4 lecture modules + 1 clinical internship module. Each module is 32 hours. The subject of each lecture module is as follows:

T5 - Sensory, Intuitive and Perceptual Diagnosis

T6 - Medical Qigong Therapy Dao Yin Exercises and Rectifying Qi Deviations

T7- Medical Qigong Therapy for Pediatrics, Geriatrics, Gynecology, Neurology, and Psychology

T8 - Introduction to Medical Qigong Therapy for Oncology (1)

In addition to the modules listed above (and the clinical module), requirements for completion of the Therapist level include 50 hours in each of the following subjects:

Basic Traditional Chinese Medicine Theory

Western Anatomy and Physiology I

Western Anatomy and Physiology II
